Food Vendor Rules and Procedures

- All vendors must submit a complete application and payment of **\$150** to reserve a food vendor space. This event is organized as a major fundraiser for the AWC Alumni Association (AWCAA)for programs and scholarships.
- All vendors must submit proof of health department food handling card with application.
- Direct Cash exchange is prohibited by food vendors. Tickets will be sold in \$1.00 denominations in various locations at the event. Vendors are to use event sponsored tickets equal to the value posted at the vendor booth and ticket booth. Vendors will return their tickets at the end of the event for a cash voucher. Any vendor disregarding the rules will immediately be penalized by paying a fine of \$100 in addition to closing down the booth.
- Checks will be issued the following week.
- Tastings offered shall be within \$1.00-\$3.00. Pre-sale tickets will be offered in denominations of \$1.00. Full meals not to exceed \$5.00 (portion accordingly).
- Vendors are only to sell items listed on the application. Soda and water may not be sold by food vendors.
- Cancellation policy: The \$150 reservation fee is non-refundable, unless approved by the AWC Alumni Association.
- A 10' x 10' shaded vendor space will be available to food vendors. Vendors must supply their own power, tables, chairs, decorations, and cooking/warming equipment, napkins and forks.
- All vendors are responsible for costs of all labor, materials, equipment, supplies and any other items necessary for the performance of their participation in the event. The event will not be liable for any debt, tax, or assessment accrued by any vendor in the operation of their booth and participation.

The vendor signing this application acknowledges they have read, understand and agree to all the Taste of Yuma Food Vendor Rules and Procedures.
